The American Psychiatric Publishing (APP) Journals and PsychiatryOnline are moving to a new domain and platform on **Monday, 31 October, at 6:00 AM Eastern Time**. The new main domain for the subscriptions listed below is **PsychiatryOnline.org**. The new technology partner is **Silverchair Information Systems**, and the platform is **SCM6**.

Silverchair and the SCM platform are the existing hosts for the book resources that have been part of PsychiatryOnline since its launch in 2005. With this transition, the journals (currently hosted by HighWire Press) will move to the Silverchair platform to join the books, and psychiatryonline.org will become the main domain for all online subscriptions. Our goal for this transition is to offer a more integrated experience on a platform that is aligned with the emerging needs of you and your users. We anticipate a smooth migration to the new platform, and offer the advice below to help you prepare.

It has been our goal in migration planning to minimize the effort for library administrators in this transition. However, there are some steps you can take—some now, some at the point of switchover to the new site—that will prepare your institution for a seamless transition. Please review this document carefully now so you will be prepared. You'll find a Migration Checklist at the end of this document to help with planning.

## Migration Action Items for Library Administrators

### Pre-Migration Authentication Confirmation and Updates

Please confirm that all authentication methods available to your institution are working on the existing HighWire sites *before 26 October*. Please also be sure to make any updates to authentication methods—for example, IP ranges—*before 26 October*. All pre-migration updates will be transferred to the new platform.

Ensuring that authentication is working correctly *now* will help to ensure a smooth transition to the new platform for your institution.

### Proxy Servers and Firewalls

If your institutional authentication system uses a firewall/proxy server that contains specific entries for approved websites and their specific IP addresses, you will need to update those entries at the time of migration. URLs and IP addresses for the new site are below. We recommend that you use the URLs to reduce the need to maintain IP addresses. The new site is scheduled to go live on **Monday, 31 October at 6:00 AM Eastern Time**—please be sure to confirm that the new site is live before making the switch.

## EZproxy Configuration

The migration will require a new EZproxy database definition for the global PsychiatryOnline site:

Title PsychiatryOnline  
 URL <http://psychiatryonline.org/>  
 DJ psychiatryonline.org

The EZproxy database definition for the PsychiatryOnline Journals remains unchanged:

Title Journals of American Psychiatric Publishing  
 URL <http://psychiatryonline.org/>  
 DJ psychiatryonline.org

Remember that the new site is scheduled to go live on **Monday, 31 October at 6:00 AM Eastern Time**—please be sure to confirm that the new site is live before making the switch.

## End-User Access via Institutional Administrator Account

We understand that some library administrators have unintentionally granted access to full-text content through their administrator username and password. APP Journal and PsychiatryOnline subscriptions do not permit full-text access to the institution through the administrator account, so librarians who have set up this type of access may lose it after migration.

A simple fix to the problem is registration of IP ranges for your institution. We encourage you to visit <http://highwire.org/librarians> before **26 October** to register your IP ranges. This will guarantee a seamless access transition.

DSM Premium and DSM-IV-TR Online Only institutional subscribers' pre-migration usage reports for books will not be integrated into the new platform interface, but they will continue to be accessible through the end of 2011 through the current interface; a link to the location for these legacy stats will be provided later. If you'd like to download book stats before migration, please visit: <http://stats.psychiatryonline.com/statistics/>.

The SCM6 platform is compliant with the current COUNTER standards (COUNTER 3 for Journals and COUNTER 1 for Books), which will be available on a going-forward basis after migration through the SCM6 institutional administrator interface. **You will be able to see your first month's usage data for the new platform on the new library administrator site as of December 2011.** Emails will be sent out on launch date to inform you of your administrator username and password and how to access your institution's usage statistics from the new platform. ## Answers to Other Important Questions

### Will I need to redo my institution's access methods on the new platform?

All registered institutional accounts, IP addresses, and administrator information will be migrated as part of the platform transition process. Be sure to update any account information or access methods **before** 26 October to make sure that they are migrated.

## **How do I update my institution's IP addresses after the launch?**

## **How do I update the administrator contact information on my account?**

Please email any changes to your institution's administrator contact information or company address to [institutions@psych.org](mailto:institutions@psych.org). We will update your account and email you verification that your account has been updated.

## **Does SCM6 work with Athens?**

Yes, the Silverchair SCM6 platform supports Athens authentication, and this authentication method is offered for the PsychiatryOnline books and journals. If you would like to add your Athens ID to your account access please email [institutions@psych.org](mailto:institutions@psych.org) with your Athens ID.

## **What will happen to links to resources in my library systems, such as link resolvers?**

We are putting in place "301 redirects" (indicating a permanent move) from the legacy site on HighWire to the new site. Whenever possible, existing links will resolve to their new location. Links that cannot be resolved to the new location will go to the homepage. Key URLs for the new site are offered below; note that URLs for the journals are not changing.

## **Do I need to ensure that my LOCKSS account is still in place?**

LOCKSS is aware of this platform move, and LOCKSS archiving will remain in place for PsychiatryOnline content after migration.

## **Do I need to update any persistent links to the textbooks or main PsychiatryOnline homepage?**

We have redirects from the .com site to the new .org domains so any persistent links you currently have should be redirected to the correct sites. However, updating links on your library pages would be ideal. But please don't do this until the launch date.
